The official opposition requests that you make public the complete information about the supplementary retirement benefit agreement that the BC Ferries' Board of Directors sanctioned for CEO David Hahn in 2006/07. Part of this packet should include the consultant's report the Board reviewed as part of making its decision.

To date, the BC Ferries Board of Directors has refused to release this paper.

We also request that your office direct the release of the supplementary retirement benefit agreements the board sanctioned for other BC Ferry executives, Michael Corrigan and Glen M. Schwartz.

The official opposition expects that your office will ensure these documents are made available online in short order given your commitment to "open government".

Premier, to date you have refused to review the bonus pensions for BC Ferries executives. Disclosing these agreements will allow us and others to test your claims that a review is not possible.
